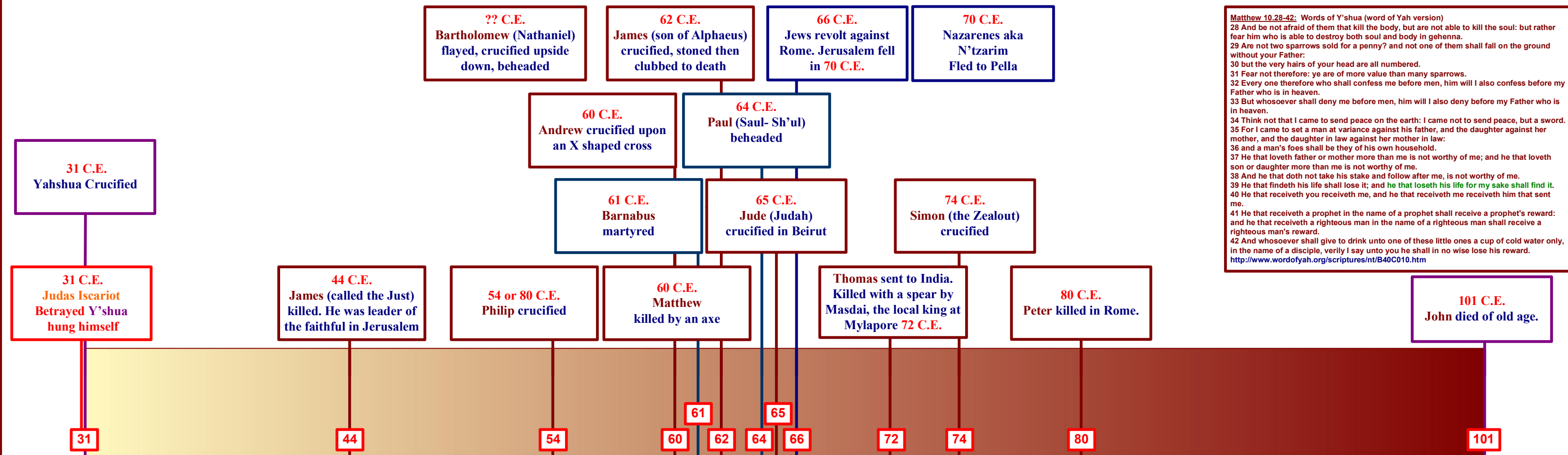


TIMELINE OF THE DISCIPLES/ APOSTLES



Matthew 10:28-42: Words of Y'shua (word of Yah version)
 28 And be not afraid of them that kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him who is able to destroy both soul and body in gehenna.
 29 Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? and not one of them shall fall on the ground without your Father:
 30 but the very hairs of your head are all numbered.
 31 Fear not therefore: ye are of more value than many sparrows.
 32 Every one therefore who shall confess me before men, him will I also confess before my Father who is in heaven.
 33 But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father who is in heaven.
 34 Think not that I came to send peace on the earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword.
 35 For I came to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law:
 36 and a man's foes shall be they of his own household.
 37 He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.
 38 And he that doth not take his stake and follow after me, is not worthy of me.
 39 He that findeth his life shall lose it; and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it.
 40 He that receiveth you receiveth me, and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me.
 41 He that receiveth a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward: and he that receiveth a righteous man in the name of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man's reward.
 42 And whosoever shall give to drink unto one of these little ones a cup of cold water only, in the name of a disciple, verily I say unto you he shall in no wise lose his reward.

THE APOSTLES OF YAHSHUA

Original Twelve Apostles picked by Yahshua and the replacement for Judas:

- Peter**, crucified upside-down in Rome c. AD 64.
- James**, (the Just or Greater) son of Zebedee was beheaded in AD 44, first of the Twelve to die (since the addition of Matthias)
- John**, son of Zebedee, no biblical record of death, he is believed to have died of natural causes due to old age- circa 101 A.D.
- Andrew**, Peter's brother, was crucified upon a diagonal or X-shaped cross- 60 A.D.
- Philip** was crucified in AD 54, some say 80 A.D.
- Bartholomew** (also known as Nathaniel) was flayed alive (skinned) and then beheaded; some sources locate his death at Derbend on the Caspian Sea- date unknown.
- Matthew** killed by an axe in AD 60.
- Thomas** was killed by four spears in Mylapore, Madras, India in AD 72 by four soldiers of Masdai the local king.
- James**, (the Lesser) son of Alphaeus, beaten to death with a club after being crucified and stoned- 62 A.D.
- Jude**, half brother of Yahshua, was crucified about 65 AD in Beirut. Possibly also known as Thaddeus.
- Simon the Zealot** was crucified in AD 74.
- Judas Iscariot** (of Issachar), according to Matthew, hanged himself after betraying Jesus. Replacement for Judas Iscariot picked by the surviving eleven:
- Matthias**, Judas' replacement, was stoned and beheaded.

Paul, also known as Saul (Sh'ul)

January 25, Conversion of Paul, Apostle (Feast)

As a "zealot for my ancestral traditions" (Galatians 1:14), Saul "persecuted the Church of God beyond measure and tried to destroy it" (Galatians 1:13). It was at his feet that those who stoned **Stephen** laid their cloaks (Acts 7:58). But on one of his journeys of persecution, the Lord Jesus called him to repentance, and Saul experienced a profound conversion (Acts 9:1 ff.). Thereafter, he preached and founded churches throughout Asia Minor in his mission as apostle to the Gentiles.

As a Roman citizen, he was exempt from crucifixion, so he was beheaded with a sword, in Rome c.64.

Barnabus

Although not one of the original 12 apostles, Barnabus is numbered among the first of the faithful at Jerusalem. He is noted for preaching at Antioch and for being a companion of Saint Paul and accompanying him on his first journey.

Barnabus was born in Cyprus, and he eventually returned there, preaching the Gospel. He was martyred c.61 at Salamis.

Simon Peter: Renamed by Y'shua to Peter (meaning rock), his original name was Simon bar Jonah;[Mk 3:16] was a fisherman from the Bethsaida "of Galilee"[Jn 1:44], cf. Jn 12:21. Also known as Simon bar Jochanan (Aram.), Cephas (Aram.).
 Andrew: The brother of Simon/Peter, a Bethsaida fisherman, and a former disciple of John the Baptist.
 James, son of Zebedee: The brother of John.
 John: The brother of James. Y'shua named both of them Bo-aner'ges, which means "sons of thunder".[Mk 3:17]
 Philip: From the Bethsaida of Galilee[Jn 1:44] [12:21]
 Bartholomew, son of Talemai; usually identified with Nathanael, who is mentioned in Jn 1:45-51.[15]
 Matthew: The tax collector. The similarity between Mt 9:9-10, Mk 2:14-15 and Lu 5:27-29 may indicate that Matthew was also known as Levi.[16]
 Thomas: Judas Thomas Didymus - Aramaic T'oma' = twin, and Greek Didymos = twin. Doubting Thomas.
 James, son of Alphaeus: Generally identified with "James the Less", and with "James the Just".
 Jude or Thaddeus: In some manuscripts of Matthew, the name "Lebbaeus" occurs in this place. Thaddeus is traditionally identified with Jude (Judah).
 Simon the Zealot: Some have identified him with Simeon of Jerusalem.]
 Judas Iscariot: The disciple who later betrayed Jesus.[Mk 3:19] The name Iscariot may refer to the Judean towns of Kerioth or to the sicarii (Jewish nationalist insurrectionists), or to Issachar. Also referred to as "Judas, the son of Simon."[Jn 6:71] [13:26] He was replaced by Matthias as an apostle shortly after Y'shua was resurrected.

Revelation 12:9-11:

9 And the great dragon was cast down, the old serpent, he that is called the Devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world; he was cast down to the earth, and his angels were cast down with him.
 10 And I heard a great voice in heaven, saying, Now is come the salvation, and the power, and the kingdom of our Elohim, and the authority of his Mashiyach: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, who accuseth them before our Elohim day and night.
 11 And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb, and because of the word of their testimony; and they loved not their life even unto death.
