## THE FEASTS OF 777, YAHWEH ELOHIM

Without the Feasts of Yahweh it is impossible to understand the Almighty's plan for the redemption and salvation of mankind.

This document is an attempt to do the topic justice for those who do not know anything about the Feasts of Yahweh or His plan of redemption. We put the leaven out of our homes and do not eat it for 7 days to show the effort to put sin out of our lives. In the Renewed Covenant this shows that Yahshua has made us sinless by His blood covering. Pictures the First Harvest- from Adam until the 7 <sup>th</sup> Trumpet.  Hebrew=Shavuot=weeks. The Feast of Weeks: count is 7 Sabbaths after the morrow of the Sabbath that falls within the Feast of Unleavened Bread, then on the morrow is the 50 <sup>th</sup> day- the first day of the week. Hellenistic Jews gave it the name Pentecost (πεντηκοστή, "fiftieth day"). Festival of Weeks (Hebrew: תג הקביר, Ḥag ha-Shavuot); Festival of Reaping (Hebrew: יום הבכורים, Yom ha-Bikkurim)   |

The nations will go through this when Yahshua returns, then go to Jerusalem to observe Chag Sukkot with our King Yahshua. Annual Personal and Global Repentance. The 8 <sup>th</sup> day is when Yahshua stood and cried, "If any man thirst" It pictures the second resurrection for those who did not have a "first chance". In prophecy it will last about 100 years. Jewish tradition considers it "Simchat Torah"- Joy of the Torah when Moses (Moshe) brought the law from Yahweh.
